- Equipment failure, failure to properly adjust or fasten equipment, and improper use of equipment
- Falls, over-exertion, and failure or remain within designated areas
- Impact or collision with trees or structures, other participants, or Guides negligence on the part of DC Tours and other providers to take reasonable steps to safeguard participants from the risks, dangers, and hazards of participating in adventure activities referred to above.
